# What's MO Healthy Food?

The Missouri Healthy Food AmeriCorps Program focuses on food access and education in six diverse locations across the state of Missouri. With 67% of students in the service region being considered food insecure, food education and access are vital to promote a healthy lifestyle and decrease the risk of diet-related diseases such as diabetes and obesity. Through their service sites, eleven State AmeriCorps Members provide hands-on farm and garden education to folks of all ages while increasing awareness and access to fresh, healthy fruits and vegetables, and directly supporting the growth of strong, vibrant, sustainable communities.

Since its inception in 2013, this program has impacted thousands of kids and adults through school, community, and home gardens. In 2015, AmeriCorps members gave 1,044 presentations related to gardening and healthy food to 9,182 students throughout Missouri. Additionally, with AmeriCorps support, four schools enhanced their outdoor classroom space in 2015. The MO Healthy Food AmeriCorps Program is supported by the Missouri River Communities Network, as well as farm and garden nonprofits throughout the state.
